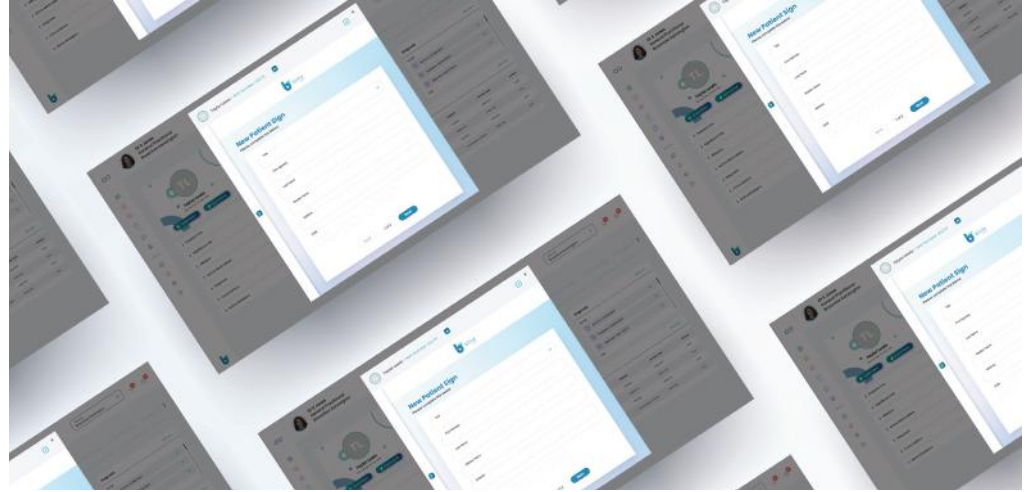




Description

PACO's Quick Forms - Mobile Consultation offers the freedom of mobile consultation, empowering healthcare staff to provide care anywhere. Quick Forms are especially valuable for home visits or duty at care homes, as all entered information is automatically coded into the patient's medical record without requiring a live connection to the clinical system.

Staff can efficiently input data using PACO Template forms or customisable general consultation forms, which can be configured by the practice. Users have the flexibility to designate the destination within the patient's medical record for each part of the consultation or direct it to a colleague for action or review, as needed.



Quick Forms not only reduce administrative burdens but also eliminate errors associated with paper note-taking and manual data re-entry. Additionally, staff can use voice input for data recording in Quick Forms.

Why is it important?

Improved Field Work: Staff who visit patients at their homes or provide care home visits face challenges with note taking on paper, followed by the tedious task of data re-entry. Quick Forms eliminate these obstacles, allowing information to be easily recorded at the point of contact, thereby reducing errors. A live connection to the GP Clinical system is not required, as PACO automatically saves data to the patient's medical record once a connection becomes available.

What it does

Mobile Access: Grants staff access to patient information via a mobile device during home visits or care home interactions, enabling direct data input into a form that is automatically saved into the patient's clinical record. Users can select where in the patient's medical record the information should be filed. Staff can also record information using their voice for added convenience.
